TOWN OF OGDEN BRUSH, STUMP & LEAF PICK-UP RULES

Please remember the following when placing brush, stumps and bagged leaves by the roadside for pickup:

- ✓ Have all brush, stumps and bagged leaves out to the curb by 7:00am Monday of the week of your quadrant pick up. Brush, stumps and leaves will be picked up using the quadrant system only. (Quadrant listing available on the web @ www.Ogdenny.com under the highway page.)
- ✓ Leaves in plastic bags cannot and will not be picked up. Plastic bags cannot be recycled and will not compost in our mulch pile. All leaves must be bagged in **bio-degradable** bags.
- ✓ Limbs should not be more than 6 to 8 feet in length.
- ✓ If the diameter is smaller than 24" the logs should not be more than 4' long. If the diameter is larger than 24" the logs should not be more than 18" in length.
- ✓ DO NOT place brush, stumps or leaves on anyone's property except for your own.
- ✓ DO NOT place brush pile, stumps or bagged leaves where they will be a sight distance problem for you, your neighbors, or other traffic.
- ✓ **Stack brush parallel with the road.**
- ✓ DO NOT place brush, stumps or bagged leaves under utility wires where our grapple truck cannot reach, if possible.
- ✓ Brush and leaves will NOT be picked up if they are in barrels, trash cans or containers.
- ✓ DO NOT place brush piles, stumps or bagged leaves in the roadway or on the road shoulder.
- ✓ Place stumps separate from brush pile. They will be picked up separately.
- ✓ **All stumps must be 90% free of all dirt and stones and no more than 6" in diameter.**
- ✓ Contractors are not permitted to bring in any stumps from another location. They will NOT be picked up.
- ✓ DO NOT include brush, stumps or bagged leaves from "lot clearing" for any construction activity. They will NOT be picked up.
- ✓ **DO NOT** place ANY other debris with your brush pile, stumps or in your leaf bags. (Examples: metal, concrete, construction materials, wood with nails, junk, "Spring clean up items" etc.) You must contact your personal waste hauler for all items except concrete. Contact our office for concrete removal.
- ✓ The Town does not pick up grass clippings.
