NOTICE

With the snow and ice season upon us, the Highway Department has a few reminders to all residents concerning snow and ice removal.

- Whether by plow, snow blower, shovel, hired contractor, or any other means, leaving snow or ice in the roadways creates a hazard for the traveling public. It is also against the law. Section 169-1 of the town code allows for a \$250 fine plus labor costs imposed on the resident for leaving snow, ice, garbage cans, recycling bins or other substances upon the highway, which includes, pavement, shoulders and ditches.
- The Highway Department will repair or replace mailboxes and posts if the damage was a result of the town's work. If replacement is warranted, it will be with a standard 4' x 4' wooden post and a standard galvanized steel box at no charge to the resident. Again, this is done as a courtesy and a custom box or posts will only be replaced with the standard materials. **DO NOT PUT YOUR MAILBOX POST IN CONCRETE.**
- Do not park your vehicle on the road, near the road shoulder or near the gutter. Local Law #5-2007 Town of Ogden winter parking ordinance number 197-24.1 states that the parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited on all highways and rights-of-way within the Town of Ogden between the hours of 7PM and 7AM from November 15th through April 15th of each year. Any vehicle found in violation of this statute shall be considered abandoned. Such vehicle shall be removed by or under the direction of the Police Department.
- Any damage to lawns as a direct result from our snow plowing operation will be repaired the following spring. We will topsoil and reseed as necessary. Lawn repairs will be handled as the weather allows and as our work schedule permits.
