NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
TO CONSIDER THE APPROVAL OF
A PROPOSED CONSOLIDATION AGREEMENT**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Town Board of the Town of Ogden will hold and conduct a Public Hearing to consider the approval of a proposed Consolidation Agreement, which agreement proposes the consolidation of all existing Sanitary Sewer Districts within the Town presently serviced by the Town of Ogden, and which Public Hearing will be held and conducted by the Town Board of the Town of Ogden on the 25th day of April, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. at the Ogden Community Center, 269 Ogden Center Road, Spencerport, NY 14559, and at which hearing all interested persons shall be heard concerning the same.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that a full and complete copy of the proposed Consolidation Agreement is presently on file at the Ogden Farmer's Library, Ogden Community Center, 269 Ogden Center Road, Spencerport, NY where it may be examined by all interested persons during normal business hours, and is also available for examination on the Town of Ogden website, www.ogdenny.com , for viewing and examination.

**DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY OF
PROPOSED CONSOLIDATION AGREEMENT**

The proposed Consolidation Agreement proposes to consolidate all existing Sanitary Sewer Districts in the Town into the "Town of Ogden Consolidated Sewer District" (CSSD). The administration of the CSSD will be with the Town Board of the Town of Ogden, and such administration will require no additional personnel or change in administrative responsibility. All existing districts and their respective assets are identified in the proposed agreement and the CSSD will own and maintain all such assets in the future. The proposed Agreement provides for all capital and maintenance costs to remain the same, with all capital and maintenance costs to be raised by taxes to remain at current levels, new or additional bonded indebtedness will be incurred by the CSSD. It is expected that the proposed consolidation will result in overall cost savings as a result of the elimination of duplication of administrative costs associated with planning, budgeting and accounting.
