

Fingerprinting

If you live or work in the Town of Ogden, you can have fingerprinting done at the police department. There is no charge but you must provide a fingerprint card and show some form of picture ID.

We are not a digital fingerprinting site and we do not do fingerprinting for pistol permits. That is done at the Monroe County Clerks Office. Here is the link <http://www.monroecounty.gov/clerk-pistolpermits.php>

Fingerprints can be done at any time by any Ogden Police Officer or the Animal Control Officer. The Animal Control Officer is available Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 8:30 – 4:30 pm and Wednesday from 2:00 – 10:00 pm at the Town of Ogden Police Department office. For any other date or time, please come to the Town Hall building, call 911 and tell them you need non-criminal fingerprints taken. An officer will meet you and let you into the building to be fingerprinted. There is no charge.
