



Grants

Grants awarded which have enhanced the operation of the Ogden Police Department include:

BUNY (Buckle Up New York)

Seat belts save lives, over 12,000 every year. In 2011, 52 percent of vehicle occupants who were killed in motor vehicle crashes nationwide were NOT wearing seat belts at the time of their fatal crashes. Seat belts have been proven to be the best defense against injuries and fatalities in motor vehicle crashes. This is funded by the Governor's Traffic Safety Committee's Buckle Up New York grant.

STEP (Selective Traffic Enforcement Program)

Another Governor's Traffic Safety Committee award, this grant helps officers concentrate on school zones, dangerous intersections, highways and neighborhoods with high incidents of motor vehicle accidents and infractions. Officers, working toward a goal of safer roads and fewer accidents, are watching for speeding, distracted and aggressive driving.

STOP DWI

Funds provided through Monroe County assist the Ogden Police to keep drunk and drugged drivers off the road. Checkpoints and patrols held throughout the year are funded by the Stop DWI grant and enhance our ability to continue to keep our roads safe.
