Upon arrival, officers and deputies encountered Quinton A. O'Connor of that address. O'Connor and another resident of the home were detained for investigation. A third resident, the victim, Timothy O'Neil, was located inside the home, deceased. The victim appears to have died from multiple gunshot wounds. A firearm was recovered at the scene. O'Connor was subsequently charged with Murder in the second degree and was arraigned in Ogden Court. He was remanded to the Monroe County Jail with no bail. This investigation is ongoing and further charges may be lodged at a later date.
